FemmeTech Inc. has an immediate opening for a senior Internet Application Developer at the Air and Space Expeditionary Force Center (AEFC), Langley AFB, in Hampton, VA. The AEFC is responsible for sourcing and scheduling Air Force unit type codes (UTCs) to support crisis and steady state rotational contingency operations, as well as joint exercises supporting combatant commanders around the world. This position will be part of a 30+ military-contractor team providing full-time support to the AEFC staff developing new applications and implementing a systems integration plan. This position will be responsible for working with team members to maintain and revise existing web applications within the AEFC, as well as developing new web applications for internal and external customers.

Educational Requirements:

B.S. Computer Science or related field. May substitute experience for education on a year-for-year basis.

Special Skills:

- Minimum 8 years experience with MS Windows platform application development.
- Minimum 5 years experience designing and developing web pages that interact with external databases using MS SQL Server 2000 and Active Server Pages (ASP) is required.
- Minimum 3 years experience with OOP is required.
- Minimum 2 years experience with C# is required.
- Minimum 2 years experience with ASP.NET is required.
- Experience with creating web services is highly desired.
- Minimum 3 years experience with VBScript and JavaScript is required.
- Working knowledge of MS SQL Server 2000 tools is required.
- Minimum 2 years working knowledge of Air Force approved industry standards for microcomputer operating systems, software development lifecycle methodologies, database administration/management applications, website management & authoring applications, and other IT applications required to share necessary files & information in both the unclassified (NIPRNET) and classified environments (SIPRNET).
- Working knowledge of USAF AEF construct, readiness policies and processes, as well as USAF UTC tasking procedures and related automated systems is desirable, but not required.
- Working knowledge of Joint Operations Planning and Execution System (JOPES) and Deliberate and Crisis Action Planning and Execution Segments (DCAPES) is desirable, but not required.
